Subject: Fourth Quarter Report, October through December, 2018

To All Board Members and Donors:

As we enter the final stretch of construction, I am pleased to say that, in the past four years, our foundation has been able to navigate the myriad of India's permits, keep construction underway with loans from Father YL's friends and relatives when our wire transfers were a bit behind, and ongoing support from the Diocese of Guntur. Of course, none of this could have transpired without the support of our many donors. The time is ripe for ONE big push to finalize the construction and begin staffing and the selection of our first class of children to be housed, clothed, fed and provided necessary medical support to enable them to become contributing members of India's future. Yes, our Mission has morphed into a proactive and positive long term program for our children and future contributors to society. (See addendum for Father YL's recap of open items and where we stand financially.)

As we conclude the first four full years of our start-up and construction costs, I would like to share our financial results and progress with our friends and interested parties in our House of Onions. Having never been involved with a 501(c)(3) foundation in the past, my only knowledge of expectations comes from reading about some of the "less than honest" organizations that have been exposed over the years. Names need not be mentioned, but we all know who they are and how little, on a percentage basis, of the donations actually get to the needy.

Over the past 4 years, we have transferred \$137,000 to Father YL in India with an additional \$10,000 the first few days of 2019. We managed to do all this with only a 2.5% administrative expense ratio over four years. All expenses, other than monies sent for construction, are tied to PayPal charges, website development and maintenance and legal setup fees. Rest assured that your contributions are being spent wisely!


